--ROSEMARY THANKED SHERRY JOHNSON FOR COORDINATING THE BOXER SEMINAR FRIDAY EVENING WITH ROBERTO ELINAN PROVIDING THE PRESENTATION.

--SHERRY JOHNSON SAID THERE WAS A PROBLEM WITH THE ROOM FOR DINNER. AN INDIVIDUAL FROM COMBINED, PRESIDENT CARL VITNER, SAID THAT GBC HAD LEFT THE ROOM IN A MESS LAST YEAR, AND BECAUSE OF THIS THE ROOM WILL BE SCRUTINIZED AFTER THE GBC VACATES THE ROOM.

VITNER REGARDING A PERSONAL APOLOGY REGARDING HIS RUDENESS.
